

# Shop AGA

Located on the main floor of the Art Gallery of Alberta, Shop AGA features unique items, including distinctive jewelry, home décor, exhibition-inspired products, art publications and more. Products exclusive to Shop AGA include Toronto-based **Takui Bags**; **Marimekko** from Finland; Sorapot teapots from New York; as well as gift cards by Ed Eaton from British Columbia, Canada.

Reminiscent of the AGA building, the shop space has been designed with a few distinctive materials. The feature blade wall and shelving units are made of 3Form Eco resin and Douglas fir wood. The wood was harvested from sustainably managed forests and is Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) certified. The lighting fixtures are outfitted with energy efficient metal halide bulbs. Completing the space are ceasarstone stone resin countertops.

The Retail Business plan was composed by **Marketplace Associates** while the design for Shop AGA was developed by **Black River Architects**, both out of out of Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA.
