Accommodations

The AGA aims to provide a welcoming environment for all guests and visitors. To foster an increasingly accessible space, we currently offer:

- Free admission for one person accompanying a person with special needs;
- Access for service animals:
- Wheelchair access to building;
- Use of a wheelchair, upon request (as per availability);
- · Automated front door;
- Ledcor Theatre ramp to stage;
- Elevator access to all floors;
- Open door/accessible washroom;
 - Auto taps/lower urinal
- Lower counter at Guest Services desk;
- Elevator braille and audio; and
- Gallery Attendant/Security protocol to facilitate access:
 - Should a guest with a visible mobility challenge require assistance accessing exhibition spaces, AGA Security and/or Guest Services staff will communicate via radio to Gallery Attendants in order to facilitate access, as appropriate. Our front line staff, including Gallery Attendants and Security staff are ready to offer information and assistance upon request.
