# **REGISTRATION**

All ticket holders, upon arrival, must register at the registration table to receive a bid number.

# STARTING BID

All lots are subject to reserves. A reserve bid is the minimum price or starting bid below which the artwork will not be sold. The reserve is approximately 60% of the Fair Market Value.

# FAIR MARKET VALUE

Fair Market Value (FMV) is the highest price, expressed in dollars, that property would bring in an open and unrestricted market, between a willing buyer and a willing seller who are both knowledgeable, informed, and prudent, and who are acting independently of each other.

# **BIDS EXCEEDING FAIR MARKET VALUE**

All bidders who pay at least 25% more than the FMV of an auction item are eligible for a Charitable Tax Receipt for the additional amount.

# **BIDDING INSTRUCTIONS**

To bid on a lot, locate the item and its accompanying bid sheet. Write your bid number (provided at Registration upon arrival) on the bid sheet, the amount you wish to bid and sign your name. Twice during the evening, at 9pm and 10pm, bidding on select silent auction items will close and the successful bid numbers will be listed on the main level of the AGA. Please respect the minimum bid increment.

# **PAYMENT**

Payment may be made by Debit, Visa, MasterCard, AMEX or cheque. Payment must be made in full the day of the sale at the cashier located on the main floor. Payment tables will open at 9.30pm.

# **REMOVAL OF PROPERTY**

Once payment has been made in full, all items may be taken home tonight, or items can be delivered (additional cost) or picked up at the AGA between May 10th and May 14th.

Unless otherwise announced by the Art on the Block Chair, all bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue. The AGA reserves the right to reject any bid. The highest bidder acknowledged by the Art on the Block Chair will be the purchaser. In the event of a dispute between bidders, or in the event of doubt as to the validity of any bid, the Art on the Block Chair will have the final decision either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the article in dispute. If the Art on the Block Chair decides that any opening bid is below the value of the lot offered, they may reject the bid and withdraw the lot from the sale. In addition, if the Art on the Block Chair, having acknowledged an opening bid, decides that any advance thereafter is insufficient, the advance may be rejected. At the final indication of sale, title to the offered lot will pass to the highest bidder acknowledged by the Art on the Block Chair, subject to the conditions set forth herein, and such bidder will pay the full purchase price. 
